In the 1990s Zach played within <u>Chateau Neuf Spelemannslag</u> and 'Harnihomba', while studying music at the <u>University of Oslo</u> (1993) and composition on Jazz program at <u>Trondheim Musikkonsevatorium</u> (1994–97). Within the trio 'Tri-Dim' (1997–2000) he released two albums together with <u>Håkon Kornstad</u> (saxophone) and <u>David Stackenäs</u> (guitar). With the steel guitarist <u>Ivar Grydeland</u> he established the record label Sofa, releasing improvisational music (2000), a collaboration that led to a master's degree in <u>improvisation</u> (2004) and the trio <u>Huntsville</u> including with <u>Tonny Kluften</u> (five albums, 2013).

Zach also collaborated in a duo with <u>free jazz</u> guitarist <u>Derek Bailey</u> (1930–2005), the Norwegian ditto <u>Anders Hana</u>, within the Norwegian trio 'No Spaghetti Edition' (four releases), and in the two orchestras <u>Batagraf</u> and <u>Magnetic North Orchestra</u> led by <u>Jon Balke</u>. In addition Zach has played on releases by <u>Karl Seglem</u> and <u>Carl Petter Opsahl</u>. He lives in <u>Madrid</u> (2004), from where he runs the record label Sillòn of solo albums (subsidiary of Sofa, which is now headed by Grydeland). [3][4]
