



Francesco Saverio Cavaliere is an Italian dancer and performer based in Rome. He graduated in 2012 at National Dance Rome Academy. During his studies he worked with several choreographers like Adriana Boriello, Ismael Ivo, Wayne McGregor, Dino Verga, Michele di Stefano, Ricky Bonavita. Before the graduation he worked as soloist with the Vancouver Dance City Theatre, under the direction of Roberta Baseggio.

From 2012 till 2015 he collaborated with the Roman ensemble MK directed by Michele di Stefano taking part to some productions like "Impression d'Afrique" and "Robinson".

In 2013 he danced in the Ismael Ivo's piece "Mishima" in the frame of Napoli Teatro Festival.

From 2014 till 2015 he collaborated with the Monica Casadei's Artemis Danza dance company.

Since May 2015 he is part of Balletto di Roma, under the artistic direction of Roberto Casarotto, dancing for several choreographers like Alessandro Sciarroni, Chris Haring, Itamar Serussi Sahar, Francesca Pennini, Giorgia Nardin, Chiara Frigo.

In 2017 he is part of the Fabrizio Favale's production "Hekla".

For Balletto di Roma he is also dance maker for the project "Danzare la Performance" in Maxxi museum in Rome.

As dance maker he collaborated also with "Opera Estate Festival Veneto" in the frame of Dance Raids Festival in Feltre.
